- MoU was signed between TEVTA & The 66 Scholarship Foundation on 01-10-2019 to award scholarships to the orphan students of TEVTA institutes (Technical and Vocational streams).
- For 4<sup>th</sup> ceremony dated **17<sup>th</sup> April, 2023,** the nominations of **137 students** (who are enrolled in TEVTA institutes and were awarded first scholarship last year) with an amount of **Rs. 1,269,984/-** have been finalized for which a cheque will be handed over to TEVTA Management by the 66 Scholarship Foundation.

  - NADRA Death Certificate of Father
  - Last paid utility bill of residence
  - Certificate of Principal Concerned (Not availing any other scholarship)
  - Paid Fee Voucher

  150 Vocational from North and Center regions) has also been initiated.
